The project will include weeding and edging the beds.

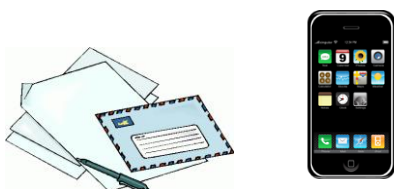
Review Evenings

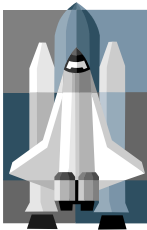

New clubs will start after Christmas!

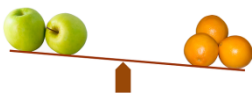
Rocket Science Experiment
